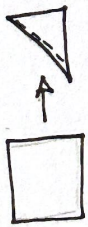


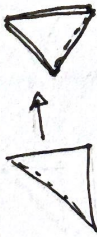
### 3-D SNOWFLAKE DIRECTIONS

① CUT 6 IDENTICAL SQUARES OF PAPER (5" is good!)

② FOLD EACH IN HALF ON THE DIAGONAL TO MAKE A TRIANGLE



③ FOLD THE TRIANGLE IN HALF TO MAKE A SMALLER ONE

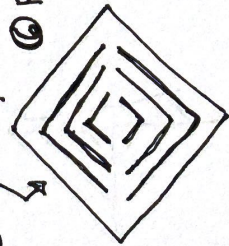


④ MAKE 3 SLITS ON THE SHORT FOLDED SIDE. IT'S EASY TO SPACE THEM EVENLY BY DOING THE MIDDLE SLIT FIRST, CUT ALMOST TO THE OPPOSITE SHORT EDGE.



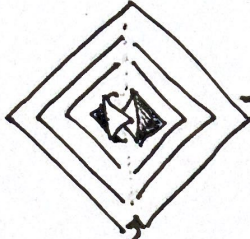
ADD SLITS TO EACH SIDE!

⑤ CAREFULLY UNFOLD THE PAPER



⑥ ROLL THE 2 POINTS CLOSEST TO THE CENTER TO MEET EACH OTHER (TO FORM A TUBE) + TAPE OR GLUE TOGETHER.

⑦ FLIP THE PAPER OVER + BRING THE NEXT 2 POINTS (THAT ARE NOW CLOSEST TO THE CENTER) TOGETHER + FASTEN

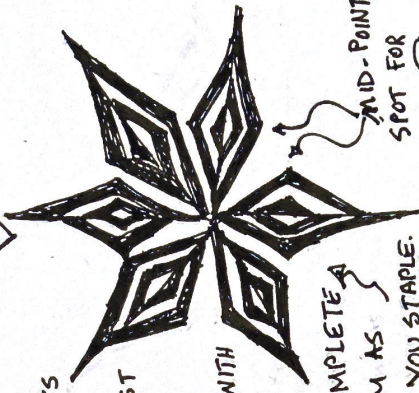


⑧ FLIP + REPEAT WITH NEXT SET OF POINTS

⑨ FLIP + REPEAT W/LAST SET OF POINTS

⑩ REPEAT STEPS 2-9 WITH THE OTHER 5 SQUARES.

⑪ NOW YOU HAVE 6 COMPLETE "ARMS". POSITION THEM AS A SNOWFLAKE BEFORE YOU STAPLE.



MID-POINT SPOT FOR STEP ⑫ STAPLING

⑫ STAPLE 3 TOGETHER AT THE INNER POINT. DO THE SAME WITH THE OTHER 3.

⑬ FASTEN THE 2 "GROUPS" TOGETHER AT THE CENTER POINT.

⑭ TO STABILIZE, STAPLE EACH ARM TO ITS NEIGHBOR AT THEIR MID-POINTS WHERE THEY TOUCH

⑮ PUNCH A HOLE AT ONE OF THE TIPS (REINFORCE W/ CLEAR TAPE) + ADD A STRING.

IT LOOKS LIKE A SNOWFLAKE!
